

Public Disclosure: University of Cincinnati-Clermont College Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: November 25, 2019

University of Cincinnati-Clermont College in Batavia, Ohio, has notified the Higher Learning Commission of its intent to voluntarily resign its standalone accreditation effective November 25, 2019.

After that date, the institution will continue to be accredited by HLC as a branch campus of University of Cincinnati. The college has been accredited by HLC since 1978.
