

## Public Disclosure: Itasca Community College Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: May 23, 2022

Itasca Community College in Grand Rapids, Minnesota voluntarily resigned its separate accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission effective May 23, 2022, in order to consolidate with the other colleges of the Northeast Higher Education District (Hibbing Community College, Mesabi Range College, Rainy River Community College and Vermilion Community College). The result is a single HLC-accredited institution called Minnesota North College.

Itasca Community College's status as a separately accredited institution expired after the effective date above. Credits and degrees earned from the institution through that date remain accredited.

Transcripts and records will be retained by and available through Minnesota North College.
